

Resume for Stephen Quiller

Stephen Quiller was born in Osmond, Nebraska in 1946. He began his formal study of art at Colorado State University where he had a scholarship in art. Over the thirty years that Quiller has been working professionally, he has become an internationally recognized artist and printmaker.

Quiller has written five books on painting in water media (two co-written with Barbara Whipple), all published by Watson-Guption Publication of New York. *Painter's Guide To Color*, *Color Choices* and *Acrylic Painting Techniques* are best selling books in print today, as are several educational videos for artists, *Complete Water Media* and *Mastering Color And Light: The Plein Air Experience*, produced by Famous Artist Films. His paintings are often on magazine covers, and he has been the subject of numerous articles in leading art magazines. Quiller instructs a few selected artist seminars each year, teaching his approach to color, water media and on-location painting.
